Dogs At Play Policies and Need-to-Know...

_____ Your dog will be interacting with other dogs while in our care. Our primary concern at all times is safety. Keeping this in mind, the choice to bring your dog to Dogs at Play or any facility/location with other dogs involves a degree of risk ranging from small scrapes and punctures (a relatively normal part of dog play groups) all the way to a potentially serious injury. Your initial here shows that you understand the risks involved in bringing your dog to a social environment.

_____ Though we are trained and work diligently to provide a safe and fun environment for all the dogs at Dogs At Play, some injuries may not be treatable by our Pet-First-Aid-Certified Staff. In the event that your dog incurs an injury requiring medical attention from a veterinarian, **Dogs At Play is not responsible for paying veterinarian, emergency or medical bills resulting from these injuries.**

_____ Our hours are Monday – Friday, 6:30am-6:30pm; Saturday and Sunday 9:00am-1:00pm, and Sunday only from 4-6pm for boarding pickup. *Hours subject to change during holidays.*

_____ If you cannot pick your dog up by 6:30pm, we enforce a strict rule of \$1.00/minute late fee. Please call us if you would like to hold your dog for up to 15 minutes at this rate; otherwise we would be happy to board your dog for an extra fee for the overnight stay and meal.

_____ Reservations are required for overnight guests. We have house food available for \$2/cup, but we encourage you to bring your dog's regular food for digestive regularity. When packing for your dog's stay, *please pack only enough food for your dog's visit, and secure it in a sealed, plastic container*. Also be sure to bring any medications they may need, and feel free to bring a blanket from home. We recommend, if possible, that you bring your dog in to play before 3:00pm. The earlier they come, the more time they get to play!

_____ Payment is due at the time services are rendered, or can be paid in advance. All credit card charges under \$50 will be charged an additional \$1 processing fee. We also have a pre-pay program for your convenience. Ask the front desk for details!

_____ We believe it is important that you view the areas where your dog will be playing and staying, and also that you have an opportunity to see your dog actively playing in the group setting. However, because each individual tour disrupts the group of dogs, we've set two strict rules:

1. Tours will given Monday-Friday between 10:00am-4:00pm, and Saturday-Sunday from 10:00am-12:00pm. We may also refuse a tour during these hours to ensure the dogs come first and have their needs met, but we will always provide a time for you to reschedule.
2. You may only watch your dog play when you come to pick up your dog. This helps your dog integrate into the group without being concerned or preoccupied of your whereabouts. For the best interest of the dogs' socialization and play, please try to limit your tour requests.

**Daycare and Overnight Care
Authorization for Veterinary Care
Agreement for Release and Waiver of Liability**

In consideration of my dog(s) participating in any way in the Daycare and/or Overnight Care program with Dogs At Play, L.L.C., I acknowledge and agree that:

1. The risk of injury to myself and/or my dog(s) is significant, including the risk of being bitten. While the supervision of the staff at Dogs At Play will minimize the risk, the risk of serious injury does exist.
2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks for myself and my dog(s), both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of those persons released from liability below, and assume full responsibility for leaving my dog(s) in the care of Dogs At Play, L.L.C.
3. In the event that my dog(s) should become ill or injured while in the care of Dogs At Play, L.L.C., I grant permission to the Dogs At Play staff to take my dog(s) to the veterinary hospital that I use. In the event that the Dogs At Play staff decides that, due to an emergency situation, it is not feasible, nor in my dog's best interest to take my dog to my veterinarian, I grant permission for the Dogs At Play staff to take my dog(s) to the veterinary hospital of their choice.
4. In the event that my dog(s) should become ill or injured while in the care of Dogs At Play, L.L.C., I understand I will not be able to obtain the name(s) of other dogs involved or owner information. This confidentiality will also be extended to myself and my dog(s) should they be involved in the injury or illness of another dog in the care of Dogs At Play, L.L.C.
5. In the event that my dog(s) should become ill or injured while in the care of Dogs At Play, L.L.C., I authorize any and all emergency care that the veterinarian and/or the staff of Dogs At Play deem necessary. In addition, I agree to assume all veterinary and hospital costs that result from the veterinary care that is deemed necessary.
6. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless Dogs At Play, L.L.C., the owners, employees, volunteers and anyone else associated with Dogs At Play, L.L.C from any and all claims as a result of illness or injury to myself or my dogs during participation in the Daycare and Overnight Care programs.

I have read this authorization of veterinary care, release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms and sign it freely and voluntarily.
